Answers for Predicting Products of Chemical Reactions For all combustion reactions of hydrocarbons or hydrogen-carbon-oxygen molecules, the products will always be CO_2 and H_2O (assuming a complete reaction). a. Combustion: $\text{C}_6\text{H}_{12} + 9\text{O}_2 \rightarrow 6\text{CO}_2 + 6\text{H}_2\text{O}$ b. Combustion: $2\text{C}_4\text{H}_6 + 11\text{O}_2 \rightarrow 8\text{CO}_2 + 6\text{H}_2\text{O}$ c. Combustion: $\text{C}_6\text{H}_{10}\text{O}_3 + 7\text{O}_2 \rightarrow 6\text{CO}_2 + \dots$

Key Concepts and Summary. Chemical equations are symbolic representations of chemical and physical changes. Formulas for the substances undergoing the change (reactants) and substances generated by the change (products) are separated by an arrow and preceded by integer coefficients indicating their relative numbers.
