I give my students Active Listening Note Taking Cards to first practice recording thoughtful questions and comments while listening to promote active thinking and listening. Note-taking often eliminates student distractions as they are focused on the speaker and the note-taking task at hand, plus they have their questions and comments ready when the speaker is ready.

Eliminate the front of the classroom To fully engage students in the learning process; the focus of instruction must shift from the teacher in front of the classroom to the actively engaged student.
