However, the German war machine could not produce enough U-boats fast enough. The Kriegsmarine had developed its requirement strategy around the war being over quickly. 60 U-boats were launched in 1940 – but this represented just over one per week. In the same year, 32 had been lost in action and 2 damaged in accidents.

## **U-boats - History Learning Site**

In fact about 60 percent of all U-boat losses during World War II took place in the period from mid-1943 to the end of the war, and of the 614 U-boats that were lost in battle, 264 were sunk by ships and 250 by aircraft. One may conclude that the Battle of the Atlantic was largely won by airpower.

In the later years of the war the U.S. Navy standardized the design and construction of the PT boat. Two basic and distinctly different types of PT Boats were built for combat with the predominant PT, the 80-foot long "Elco" boat, and the slightly smaller 78-foot long "Higgins" boat. By the end of World War II, 399 Elco PTs had been built.
